By car

By train and bus or bicycle

Thor Park is easily accessible from Genk station (distance 5 km). There is a direct bus connection to Thor Park. Bicycle and car rentals are also available.

Genk station: take the G1 bus in the direction of Waterschei to Thor Park. Stop at 'Waterschei Thorpark', at the entrance of the park. It's scheduled twice every hour and a one-way trip is approx. 16 minutes. Other possibility is Lines G1 and 3: Waterschei Mijn-stop, 2-minute walk to Thor Park.

Thor Park is easily accessible through the Limburg cycling network (junctions 508 and 509) or through the cycle paths along the public road. The park is 5 km away from Genk train station.
