About the team and the position

The Ear, Nose and Throat (ENT) department at the Curaçao Medical Center (CMC) consists of five (5) ENT specialists who take on the entire spectrum of ENT care. There is close cooperation with other specialists, including multidisciplinary consultation for sleep apnea and oncology.

Working at the Curaçao Medical Center is diverse, challenging and satisfying due to a nice combination of private practice and academic level of care. Due to the departure and retirement of two ENT specialists, two (2) vacancies will become available. We are looking for two (2) all-round ENT specialists who are collegial, friendly and flexible and who would like to work within a well-functioning team. Experience and/or sub specialization is desirable but not necessary.

Curaçao is an island with more than 150,000 inhabitants. It is a tourist destination, especially for diving and its beautiful beaches. Curacao Medical Center is a state-of-the-art hospital with 300 beds that meets all the requirements and ambitions of contemporary medicine.
